Degree Programmes	
Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) - Upgrading Programme.	1. Mean Grade C (Plain) at KCSE or equivalent with a Diploma in Nursing or Division II at KCE/EACE with a Diploma in Nursing; OR , 2. KACE or equivalent with at least one (1) Principal pass and two (2) Subsidiaries at KACE with a Diploma in Nursing. In addition, one must have at least two (2) years working experience after attainment of the Diploma in Nursing.
Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) - Direct Entry	Mean Grade C+ (Plus) at KCSE or equivalent with at least C+ (Plus) in Chemistry, Biology, Physics/Mathematics and English/Kiswahili or Physical Sciences, Biological Sciences, Mathematics and English/ Kiswahili.
Bachelor of Science in Community Health & Development	1. Mean grade of C+ (Plus) in KCSE with at least C+ (Plus) in biology, and any three of the following subjects: Mathematics, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Geography, History, English/ Kiswahili, Home Science/Agriculture; OR 2. Mean grade C (Plain) and a Diploma in Environmental and Community Development or a related area with Credit Pass from an institution recognized by Senate plus at least C+ (plus) in in any two of the following subjects: Mathematics, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Geography, History, English/Kiswahili, Home Science/ Agriculture.

Application forms can either be obtained from the Admissions Office, University of Embu, or downloaded from the University of Embu website at www.embuni.ac.ke and should be submitted upon a payment of a non-refundable application fee of KSh. 4,000 for Ph.D., KSh. 2,000 for Masters and Bachelors, KSh. 1,000 for Diploma and KSh. 500 for Certificate for East Africans and USD 100 for Ph.D., USD 50 for Masters and Bachelors, USD 25 for Diploma and USD 15 for Certificate for non-East Africans.
